Ranked List Notes

1. Rudy Salakory did not score proposals 21-1103, 21-1104, 21-1107, 21-1108, or 21-1130 due to potential conflicts of interest with Cowlitz Indian Tribe and Columbia Land Trust projects.
2. Jared McKee was appointed to the TAC after the grant round had already started so did not score the projects.
3. Chris Mongeon did not submit score and did not attend the TAC ranked project meeting.
4. Alex Uber and David Lindley did not attend the TAC ranked project meeting however their scores and supporting rationales were incorporated into the draft ranked list.
5. Proposals 21-1107 and 21-1139 total project scores were tied, but the TAC recommended ranking Erverst Tide Gate (21-1139) above The Shire (21-1107). The rationale for this is that The Shire may have cost savings due to requested material changes.
6. Funding availability: \$4,000,000 is allocated to the Lower Columbia regional organization. Of this, \$108,000 is provided to the Klickitat Lead Entity to fund projects benefiting Lower Columbia salmon populations and \$100,000 is recommended for funding of the regional monitoring proposal (21-1126: Winter Steelhead Escapement Analysis Monitoring). The remaining allocation (\$3,792,000) is set aside for funding the proposals in the above table.
7. The Snake River Salmon Recovery Board is providing funding to support Snake River populations. The funding, \$42,309, has been applied to 21-1139 Erverst Tide Gate Project.
8. SW WA Nutrient Enhancement received a Low score. This project will not be identified as an alternate on the list because it is not eligible for funding with the Low score .
9. **The remaining \$7,305 from the allocation will be applied to Klickitat LE project 21-1241 Upper Rattlesnake Creek Conservation Project. This amount, along with the allocated \$108,000, provides a total of \$115,305 for Lower Columbia populations in the Klickitat LE.
